Chapter Activities, this period

Member meetings

ISOC Norway has organized 3 meetings during this period. The meetings were open for all.

02.03.2023: Evening workshop: ICANN and current challenges on the internet.

In cooperation with The Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers (ICANN), ISOC Norway, Norsk Forening for Jus og EDB (nfje.no) and iQ Global (iq.global).

22.04.2023: Can Open Source communities survive the coming EU laws?

Fireside chat with Simon Phipps (Director of EU Policy at OSI) where we explore the upcoming cyber security regulations from EU, and discuss possible consequences and remedies for businesses and the Open Source communities they depend on.

26.09.2023: A session discussing Cryptography.

Cooperation between ICANN and ISOC Norway.

Political work

- Continuous lobbying against DNS-blocking
- Working to block the CSAR¹ proposal, partially in conjunction with ISOC Europe.

ISOC works on this due to these both threatening the Internet infrastructure.

Public consultations and public letters submitted by ISOC Norway:

- ISOC Norway attended a Public hearing on DNS Blocking and submitted their input to the hearing.²
- ISOC Norway responded to a hearing given by NORID the top level administrator for .NO, on removing restrictions for registering category sub domains³.

- There have been no scheduled NORPOL meetings in this period.
